

First Issue of ECsafeSEAFOOD Project Newsletter Now Available

The first issue of the **ECsafeSEAFOOD** project newsletter is now available to download from the project's website: <u>www.ecsafeseafood.eu</u>. **ECsafeSEAFOOD** is a four-year EC FP7-funded project that aims to assess food safety issues related to priority contaminants present in seafood as a result of environmental contamination (including those originating from harmful algal blooms and those associated with marine litter) and evaluate their impact on public health.
